

## **WARRIORS BASKETBALL CAMP TO CELEBRATE 20<sup>TH</sup> ANNIVERSARY** **2019 Summer Schedule to Include 33 Camp Sessions at 23 Locations throughout the Bay Area**

OAKLAND, Calif. – The back-to-back NBA Champion Golden State Warriors announced today that [Warriors Basketball Camp](#), powered by Under Armour, the global leader in sports performance and innovation, will begin celebrating its 20<sup>th</sup> Anniversary by hosting 33 camp sessions at 23 Bay Area locations this summer. In celebration of 20 years of Warriors Basketball Camp, the team will host a Golden Giveaway, featuring 20 prizes to be distributed over the course of 10 months. Since its inception in the summer of 2000, Warriors Basketball Camp has hosted over 55,000 youth from across the United States in hundreds of sessions in 27 cities around the Bay Area, plus a camp in Oahu, Hawaii. In addition to campers from throughout the U.S., Warriors Basketball Camp has hosted youth from six continents: Africa, Asia, Australia, Europe, North America and South America. Attendance in Warriors Basketball Camp has topped over 4,000 boys and girls in each of the last two summers.

Over the last 20 years, over 250 guest appearances have been made by Warriors players and coaches at various camps sessions. In the past year alone, current Warriors players Jordan Bell, Quinn Cook, DeMarcus Cousins, Stephen Curry, Jacob Evans III, Jonas Jerebko, Damian Jones, Damion Lee, Shaun Livingston and Kevon Looney have appeared at Warriors Basketball Camp sessions. In addition, Warriors assistant coaches Mike Brown and Willie Green, former Warriors players and coaches Kelenna Azubuike, Jim Barnett, Tony Delk, Adonal Foyle, Tim Hardaway, Aaron Miles, Zaza Pachulia, Jason Richardson, Garry St. Jean. WNBA legends Jennifer Azzi, Ruthie Bolton and Sheri Sam have also made guest appearances.

This year's summer schedule is highlighted by 29 general sessions, which focus on individual skill development, the importance of fundamentals and the development of a healthy team attitude for boys and girls, ages 7-15, of all skill levels and abilities. Warriors Basketball Camp will also host a High Potential session for boys and girls ages 11-17 as well as a Girls Skills Camp for girls ages 7-15.

In addition, Warriors Basketball Camp will host two overnight camp sessions this summer. For the seventh consecutive year, the team will host an overnight camp in the Monterey area at California State University, Monterey Bay featuring Warriors guards Quinn Cook and Shaun Livingston (June 23-26), and for the second consecutive year the team will return to the University of San Francisco to host an overnight camp featuring Warriors forward Jordan Bell and center Damian Jones (June 29-July 2).
